HISTORY

The New Haven County Bowling Association was originated with two important purposes to fulfill: to provide the guidance and organization required for better bowling and to act as an extension of the American Bowling Congress for big pin bowlers in the New Haven County area.

Its members can enjoy unhampered competition where records are established only in the hope that they can be broken. While some bowlers compete for top honors and others must settle for lesser honors the Association, nevertheless, regards all its members with pride.

Although the Association appears relatively young to most of its members, it is one of the oldest in the country. It perhaps began in 1904 when a group of bowlers led by the famous Johnson family began ten pin bowling in the New Haven area. This group went on to affiliate themselves with an organization, in the eastern part of the country, known as the "National Bowling Association" who vied for supremacy with the "American Bowling Congress." When the National folded up several years later, approximately around 1914, the New Haven bowling fraternity joined with the ABC.

Bowlers who have distinguished themselves in the Bowling Circle and who should be given credit for putting the Association in the limelight are: the Johnson brothers, Frank, Charlie, Harry, and Eddie, and also George Kelsey, Joe Porto, Mortimer Lindsey, Peter Moran, Frank Garrah, Bill Enright, Herman Trisch, Charlie Lobdell, Merle Figuenick, Pete Valenti and many others, and of course Jim Hunter, our everlasting secretary.

We, the Association membership, salute these men who have devoted much of their time to make ten pin bowling a sport which today can be enjoyed by everyone, young and old.


