

### **25 Facts About Bowling**

That you should memorize. And brag about.

- 1. Bowling has more registered, dues-paying participants than any other sport in the world, bar none
- 2. More than 100 million people in 90 countries bowl at least one game a year
- 3. More than 12 million people around the world compete in organized bowling leagues.
- 4. Nearly nine million people in the United States are registered, dues-paying league bowlers.
- The Women's International Bowling Congress (3.9 million members) is the world's largest organization of registered, dues-paying athletes.
- 6. The American Bowling Congress (3.8 million) is the largest group of registered, dues-paying male athletes.
- 7. The Young America Bowling Alliance (740,000) is the second largest group of registered junior athletes. (Little League, 2.2 million, is the biggest. In terms of individual dues-paying members, however, YABA is tops.)
- 8. About 60 million people in the United States bowl at least one game a year
- 9. There are more than 150,000 lanes in over 8,000 centers in America.
- 10. There are more than 210,000 lanes in 11,600 centers around the world.
- 11. Total annual bowling revenues in America (linage, equipment, supplies, uniforms, food, beverage) are \$4 billion.
- 12. Total annual bowling revenues around the world are over \$5 billion.
- 13. The basic rules for tenpin bowling are identical in every country around the world.
- 14. The basic equipment for tenpin bowling is identical around the world.
- 15. Bowling is one of the oldest sports in the world. It was played as early as 5,200 B.C.
- 16. Established in 1913, Bowlers Journal is the oldest monthly sports magazine in America.
- 17. The Pro Bowlers Tour on ABC-TV consistently gets better ratings than any other sport in the same time slot
- 18. The WIBC Tournament is the largest annual sports event in the world.
- 19. The ABC Tournament is the largest annual men's sports event in the world.
- 20. Bowlers donate far more money to charity than any other group of athletes
- 21. The bowling industry spends far more money than any other sport on airlines, hotels, restaurants and rental cars

- 25. Total world-wide capital investment in bowling (land, buildings, equipment, etc.) is at least \$10 billion.


