## BVL Tournament Rules

1. Any person sanctioned with the NHCUSBC is eligible to bowl in this tournament. Individuals, who are not a sanctioned bowler in New Haven County, may purchase an unattached county membership for \$8.00, or for those persons not sanctioned at all, may purchase an unattached membership for \$19.00. Any bowlers holding a PBA membership card are eligible to bowl in this tournament with the following provisions: Only one card holder will be allowed to bowl on a two person team.
2. The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis being determined as 100% of the difference of the bowler's highest sanctioned average (in any county) for the 2012-2013 season (averages posted on Bowl.com shall be final) and a scratch average of 230. If a bowler does not have an established average they must use their highest 2013-2014 season average with a minimum of 21 games. Please provide a current standing sheet showing such average. The ten pin rule will be in effect. Youth averages will be accepted. All others will bowl scratch. There will be no negative handicap. **ALL AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED.**
3. The doubles team may consist of any combination of genders. The doubles partners may include one man and one woman or two men and 2 women.
4. Entries submitted by the closing date will ensure an entry into the tournament. Squad times will be assigned on a first come first serve basis based on availability. Walk-ins may be permitted if lanes are available, but are not guaranteed.
5. The prize fee will be returned 100% with 50% of prize money allocated to handicap prizes and the other 50% donated to BVL/The Bowlers to Veterans Link.
6. In the case of a tie for first place, co-champions will be declared. Prize money will be combined and equally divided. Prize money will be returned one in every seven (7) entries.
7. There will be multiple entries allowed, but a doubles team may cash **ONLY** once with the same partners.
8. All bowlers shall report to the tournament sign in desk at least a ½ hour prior to bowling to present sanction cards and to verify line-up and lane assignment.
9. These and other rules deemed necessary by the Tournament Management shall govern.
10. **NOTICE TO ALL BOWLERS:** Read Rule 319e of the USBC Rule Book on the bowler's responsibility to submit averages. Your compliance with this rule is **MANDATORY** if you meet the requirements. Read Rule 319d. It is the bowler's responsibility to report their scores in any tournament in which they have qualified for \$300.00 or more in any event.
11. Unmarried grade/high school students under the age of 18 must have their parent's/guardian's written authority to enter. Said authorization must accompany entry form prior to participation unless the bowler is accompanied by their parent/guardian, in which case authorization form may be filed up to the time the bowler starts to bowl. **WARNING TO ALL YOUTH BOWLERS:** You may jeopardize your amateur standing by bowling in this tournament or any tournament where cash prizes are awarded.
12. Prize monies shall be distributed within 30 days of the completion of the tournament and the verification of averages.
13. **The following dress code is required of all bowling participants: A collared shirt must be worn by all bowlers, mock T's will be allowed, but T-shirts are not acceptable. Men may wear slacks, casual trousers or jeans (which must be neat, clean and have no holes). Women may wear skirts, slacks, casual trousers, skorts, capris or jeans (which must be neat, clean and have no holes). No shorts or sweats are allowed.**
14. All above rules apply, unless specified in this section.
